Title of Message :
The Blessings of a S.M.A.R.T. Mother

Scripture Text: Proverbs 31:10-31

Key Verse 28: Her children rise up and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her

Introduction:

For thousands of years, God-fearing women have looked to the noble, or virtuous woman as their ideal (Proverbs 31:10) Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ, probably had this role model of the virtuous woman in the forefront of her mind from earliest childhood. Most Jewish women did. But what about today's woman? Or what value can this ancient poem be to the diverse, complex life-styles of women today? To the married, to the single, to the young, to the old, to those working outside the home or inside the home, to those women with children or without children? It is more relevant than you might at first expect - although it is also too good to be true.

1. Biblical Ideal of Womanhood v11-17
 - 1:1 We do not find the stereotyped housewife occupied with dirty dishes & laundry
 - 1:2 Her daily life dictated by the demands of her husband & her children
 - 1:3 Neither do we find a hardened, overly ambitious career woman who leaves her family to fend for itself
2. Strong Dignified, Multi-talented, Caring Woman v18-23
 - 2:1 In Her own right

- 2:2 Has money to invest, servants to look after & real estate to manage
- 2:3 Husband's partner - completely trusted with responsibilities
3. Has Business Skills v24-28
 - 3:1 Buy And Sell in the market
 - 3:2 Compassion To Care & Fulfill the needs of the less fortunate
 - 3:3 Cheerfully & Energetically Tackles Daily Challenges
 - 3:4 Her husband and children Love her

Reflection on this message:
