### Reflection on This Message.

To walk into the miraculous realm with our Lord, we need to understand a balance of God's Power and Authority. After all, we all believe our God is a miracle working God. There is no problem with HIM. But why are we not seeing much miracles. It is the acting out for the miraculous is the hardest.
