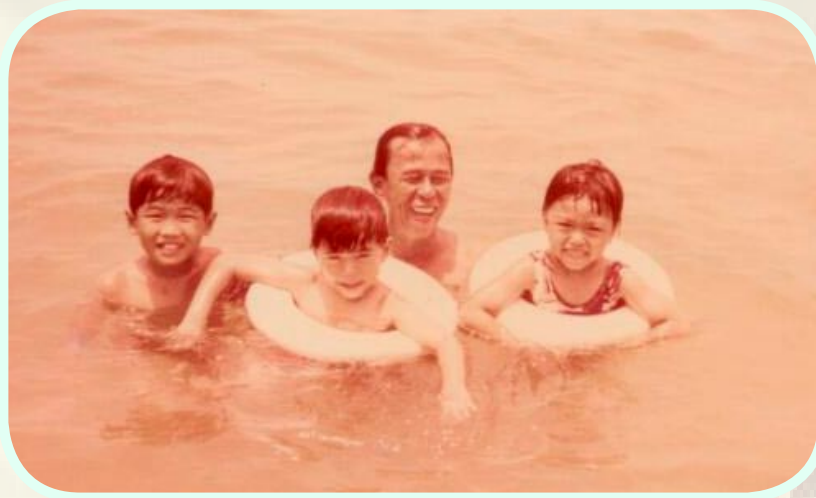

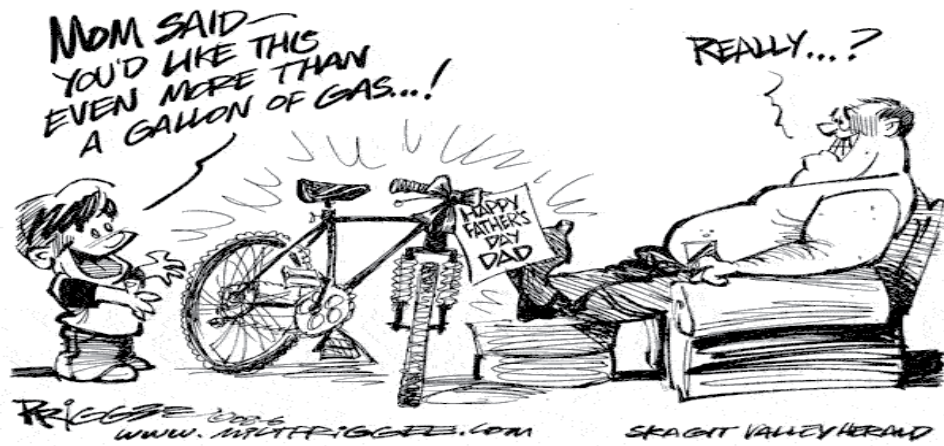

Title of Message: As your heavenly Father is perfect, be a perfect father.

Key verse: Matthew 5 :43 - 38

In this world, there are many parents parenting their children, because there is not a single perfect parent, therefore there is not a single perfect child. However, today the bible tells us, our Abba Father, whom we believe is perfect, therefore we will become perfect. Maybe we have heard of one who claims, "he/she is a perfect parent", but we know if he/she does not parent his/her child in the right path, he/she cannot claim to be a perfect person.

"Perfect" is not what one claims oneself to be, but rather when he/she is able to become perfect for the benefits of others, then this is a perfect person.

Therefore, when Jesus says "Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect", he does not mean man will be perfect, but rather we can receive God's perfect blessings. In the beginning, the man whom God created is not perfect; rather God created a being that is able to receive perfect blessings. The other animals are not qualified to receive God's perfect blessings. Therefore, God gives man commandments and initiate covenant with man.

How can we be perfect, as our heavenly Father is perfect?

1. Genuine'Prayer Life (Verse 44)
2. 'Genuine'Love Life (Verse 45-46)
3. 'Genuine'Moral Life (Verse 47-48)
